## Checklist for Services to New Cities

The County is required to provide services to new cities through the requisite transition period unless notified otherwise by the city in accordance with its enabling legislation. The city should enter the applicable date(s) in the appropriate column to give the County notice of when they will assume the delivery of each service listed in Section I. The city's selection of a takeover date constitutes the requisite notice or agreement for service takeover as provided by the relevant legislation authorizing the creation of the city. Topics in Section II are provided to assist the new city in identifying the many issues to consider prior to incorporation.
