During the General Assembly sessions, legislation was once again introduced to create the City of South Fulton. Each time, this legislation failed to garner the support needed for passage.



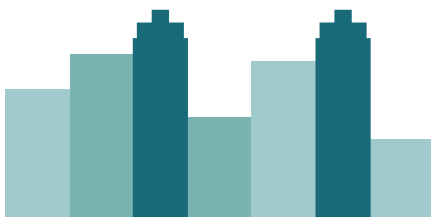
leading an effort

In response to renewed efforts to create the City of South Fulton, members of the **Loch Lomond, Sandtown, and South Oaks** communities have lead an effort to annex their respective neighborhoods into the City of Atlanta through the petition method.

After gathering the signatures of more than

60% of the registered voters and landowners

in these respective communities, petitions for annexation have been submitted to Atlanta for approval.



Upon completion of the required months long administrative and legislative process, these neighborhoods, upon approval by the Atlanta City Council, will become a part of the city of Atlanta.



future students

City of Atlanta has filed a lawsuit that, if successful, could allow current and future students living in the proposed annexed areas to attend Fulton County schools.



STATE LAW

currently prohibits the annexation of Fulton Industrial Blvd into any existing or proposed city.

The City of Atlanta has filed a lawsuit to have that issue resolved as well.
